All the Assistant Director of Drugs Control are informed that the following
change is made in the working pattern of Senior Drugs Inspector/Drugs Inspector
with immediate effect.

I.SENIOR DRUGS INSPECTOR:

A.INSPECTION

(a) The Senior Drugs Inspector shall inspect all the manufacturing units
including Blood Bank and Approved Laboratories in his Zone and submit the
inspection report forthwith to the Asst. Director of Drugs Control
concerned. The inspection shall cover all aspects of the manufacturing and
allied activities of the unit concerned. They shall conduct not less than 20
(Twenty) inspections in a month.

(b) The Senior Drugs Inspector shall inspect the Government Hospital and
Private Hospitals as per law.

B.PROSECTUION:-

The Senior Drugs Inspector shall launch at least one prosecution / submit
one proposal for suspension / cancellation of license once in every quarter of
the year.

C.SAMPLING:-

The Senior Drugs Inspector shall draw not less than 5 samples every month
and these samples shall be from Government Hospitals and manufacturing
units. Sample has to be drawn from every manufacturing Unit in his Zone
at least once in a year. In case of necessity, samples can be drawn from Private
Hospitals according to the provision of Drugs and Cosmetics Act.

II. DRUGS INSPECTOR:-

A. INSPECTION

The Drugs Inspector shall carry out statutory inspection of sales premises as well as inspection for grant / renewal of licence in his range. In range where there is no notified Inspector, the Senior Drugs inspector or Senior Most Inspector in the Zone shall inspect the premises for Grant / Renewal of licence.

The Drugs Inspector shall carry out not less than 50 inspections in a month. Every aspect of the Drugs Laws in vogue shall be covered during inspection and that shall reflect in the inspection report. Emphasis shall be on the detection of Not of Standard / Spurious / Adulterated Drugs, offences under Drugs Price Control Order, Drugs and Magic Remedies (OA) Act and sale of Psychotropic Drugs, in violation of the condition of licence.

(b) PROSECUTION:-

The Drugs Inspector shall launch minimum one prosecution every quarter of the year without fail.

(c) SAMPLING:-

The Drugs Inspector shall draw not less than seven samples in a month. These samples shall be picked up from Retail / Wholesale / Restricted sale outlet / Hospitals / Primary Health Centre / Corporation / Municipal Stores etc., Not less than 3 samples shall be drawn from Government Hospitals etc., Sampling shall be judicious and sample shall be drawn from all categories of Drugs administered through various routes of the body. At least one Cosmetics and one parentals shall be drawn once in a month of the year.

Sampling shall be planned to avoid hasty and last minute sampling.

The receipt of this instruction should be acknowledged forthwith.






